1. FTE (full-time equivalent) = Fall Undergraduate hours divided by 15, graduate-1 (master's level) hours divided by 12, and graduate-2 (doctoral level) hours divided by 9. The divisors 15, 12 and 9 are considered the standard credit course load taken by a full-time student at the under-level respectively. Each first professional student is counted as one FTE. Includes health sciences and first professional students. students enrolled on campus and off-campus.
  2. Two year institutions converted from quarter to semester system Fall 1998, except Southern Union CC which converted Fall 2000.
  3. Historical numbers are changed to reflect mergers. See explanation in Appendix i (1).
  4. Walker College merged from a private institution with UAB in 1994-97; is included in Beville State CC.
  5. Alabama Aviation & Technical College merged with Wallace CC-Dothan in Aug. 1997; Sparks St. Technical College merged with Wallace CC-Dothan Oct. 1999.
  6. Patterson St. Technical College merged with Trenholm St. Technical College in Aug. 2002.
  7. Enterprise State Junior College merged with the Aviation Campus and Aviation Center of George C. Wallace Community College-Dothan in May 2003. The consolidated institution is known as Enterprise-Ozark Community College.
  8. Gadsden State Community College merged with Ayers State Technical College in May 2003. The consolidated institution is known as Gadsden State Community College.
  9. L. B. Wallace Junior College merged with MacArthur St. Technical College in May 2003. The consolidated institution is known as Lurleen B. Community College.
  10. Pursuant to Act 2006-230, the legal status of Marion Military Institute (MMI) has changed from a private, independent junior college to a public junior college.
