- NOTES:
1. FTE (full-time equivalent) = Fall Undergraduate hours divided by 15, graduate-1 (master's level) hours divided by 12, and divided by 9. The divisors 15, 12 and 9 are considered the standard credit course load taken by a full-time student at the under-level respectively. Each first professional student is counted as one FTE. Includes health sciences and first professional students. Includes all students enrolled on campus and off-campus.
 2. Historical numbers are changed to reflect mergers. See explanation in Appendix i (1).
 3. Enterprise State Junior College merged with the Aviation Campus and Aviation Center of George C. Wallace Community College-Dothan in May 2003. The consolidated institution is known as Enterprise State Community College.
 4. Gadsden State Community College merged with Ayers State Technical College in May 2003. The consolidated institution is known as Gadsden State Community College.
 5. L. B. Wallace Junior College merged with MacArthur St. Technical College in May 2003. The consolidated institution is known as Lurleen B. Wallace Community College.
 6. Pursuant to Act 2006-230, the legal status of Marion Military Institute (MMI) has changed from a private, independent junior college to a public junior college.

Beginning Fall 2006 Enrollment and FTE numbers may include Distance Education students for some institutions.
